



Austria General Information

- Size of the country: 84000 km²
- Population: about 8.1 Mill.
- Capital: Vienna (1.6 Mill)
- Language: German
- Democratic Republic since 1918
- 9 Provinces



- Highest Mountain: Großglockner 3900 m
- Main business: tourism, forestry and wood, music, steel industry, etc.

Forestry in Austria



- Forest Area: 3.96 Mill. ha or 47.2% of the country
- The forest is owned by ...
 - 15 % the state of Austria
 - 31 % by private companies > 200 ha
 - 54 % by small land owner and farmers
- Five national parks

Forest Management in Austria

- 75.3 % needle trees
- 24.7% broad leaves
- Total standing volume: 1,094 Mill. m³ or 325 m³/ha
- Annual increment: 9.3 m³/ha
- Annual cut: 18.8 Mill. m³ or 5,6 m³/ha
- ~ 60% of increment is cut

- 4 Training centers for Farmers and forest workers
- 1 Forestry School: 5 year program
- University Programs at BOKU

 - Master
 - Ph.D.

History BOKU - University of Natural Resources

- **1872** Foundation of the University, first programs in Agricultural and Forestry
- 1883 Establishment of Land & Water resource Management program
- **1906** The BOKU earns the right to award doctoral degrees (Dr.nat.techn.)
- 1917 The title "Diplom-Ingeneur" is introduced

History BOKU - University of Natural Resources

- 1945 Food science & Biotechnology program is established
- 1981 First students in the Landscape Planning program
- **1984 Supplementary course Technical** Environmental
- 2003 Implementation of the Bologna agreements (Bachelor, Master, Ph.D.)

BOKU in Figures

- Institutes: 40
- Service Centers: 10
- Total number of students: 6000
- Foreign Students from around 70 countries: 600

Teaching staff

- **Professors and other scientists:** 322
 - Other local teaching staff: 330
- **Technical and administrative staff:** 385
- Partnerships with other Universities: 40



BOKU – University Latest Developments

- With 1.1.2004 all Universities in Austria are independent and get a state guaranteed budget
- Universities are responsible for the internal organization, budget spending, education programs, hiring of professors, etc.
- BOKU as all other Universities in Austria is under a reorganization procedure

Structure of the "New BOKU"




Institutes as Units of a Department
